Membership Categories

BUILDER CATEGORY

Shall be limited to any individual proprietorship, partnership, firm, corporation, or other entity that is engaged in the business of marketing post frame buildings, and is a member in good standing of the MFBA.

SUPPLIER CATEGORY

Any individual proprietorship, partnership, firm, corporation, or other legal entity which, in the opinion of the Board of Directors, is engaged in the manufacture or sale of materials, equipment, machinery, or services relating to and used for post frame construction.

Supplier members must, in the opinion of the Board of Directors, be qualified to render a special or distinct type of service to the post frame industry and have major business objectives to the furtherance of the post frame industry.

ASSOCIATE CATEGORY

Any person, partnership, firm, corporation, or other legal entity which, in the opinion of the Board of Directors, is engaged in a business rendering service to the industry, but not qualified for any other category in membership, including those engaged in building design or inspection and code enforcement.

BRANCH MEMBERSHIP

Any individual proprietorship, partnership, firm, corporation, or other legal entity which, in the opinion of the Board of Directors, is already a current dues paying member of the Association, will be eligible for a branch membership at \$75.00 per location in the state of Michigan. In order to be eligible, the "home office" of such a branch must be a member in good standing of the Association. A branch member shall be defined as a wholly owned subsidiary of the parent organization operating under the same name as the parent organization, but a different headquarters location. Those companies that would otherwise qualify as branch members under the aforementioned criteria, but which are operating under a different name than that of the parent company, must join in the appropriate MFBA category division.

HONORARY MEMBERSHIP

Any person who has held Builder, Supplier, or Associate membership in the Association, or has otherwise been active in MFBA's affairs, rendering the Association a conspicuous service, and is deemed worthy of this honor by the Board of Directors, may be made an Honorary Member of this Association.
